Funds raised during "Hand In Hand: A Benefit for Hurricane Harvey Relief Telethon" will help Habitat assist more families to repair or rebuild their homes

[LA VERNE, CA] (Sept. 07, 2017)—Habitat for Humanity's response to Hurricane Harvey got a boost as one of six beneficiaries of *Hand in Hand: A Benefit for Hurricane Harvey Relief* telethon that aired nationally on Tuesday, Sept. 12, from 8-9 p.m. EDT. The telethon featured some of the nation's biggest stars who came together to raise funds for those affected by Hurricane Harvey. Funds raised for Habitat for Humanity went directly to support the organization's response to Harvey.

The telethon included appearances by stars including George Clooney, Jamie Foxx, Karlie Kloss, Beyoncé, Matt Lauer, Rob Lowe, Matthew McConaughey, Norah O'Donnell, Dennis Quaid, Julia Roberts, Kelly Rowland, Adam Sandler, Ryan Seacrest, Michael Strahan, Blake Shelton, George Strait, Barbra Streisand, Oprah Winfrey, and many more. The telethon was aired nationally on ABC, CBS, CMT, FOX and NBC, as well as on Facebook, Twitter and YouTube.

As part of its response to Hurricane Harvey, Habitat has begun deploying Mobile Response Units and Disaster Corps volunteers to the region to begin rapid assessments. There are about 30 local Habitat for Humanity offices throughout the parts of southeast Texas and southwest Louisiana affected by the storms. With their help, Habitat for Humanity International is assessing the shelter and housing needs in areas impacted by the hurricane and developing response options.

In addition to long-term housing repair and construction, Habitat's response includes organizing volunteers and resources to help with the cleanup of damaged by wind and flood waters. Construction plans will be determined after evaluations and will depend on the level of support received from donors, volunteers, corporate partners and other community organizations.

The first time Reggie Varra came into the Pomona Valley Habitat office we knew he was something special. Having retired and wanting to help in the community, the *A Brush With Kindness* Committee was a perfect fit. There was something in his smile that stretched from ear to ear and that twinkle in his eye that should have prepared us for the massive change that Reggie would put

into action. Before we knew it Reggie began working during the week to prepare the projects for weekend volunteers; he worked with the solo committee chair (another fabulous volunteer - Dick Clippinger) to organize faster turn around on pending ABWK projects; he became an on site crew chief; worked with city officials to alleviate pressure on homeowners; eventually became co-chair of

Always positive, motivating others, spearheading new assignments, Mr. Varra is a physical manifestation of our mission statement, "Seeking to put God's love into action, PVHFH brings people together to build homes, communities and hope." We always knew he was something special, but the extent of Reggie's heart and faith in action still surprises us as it appears to be limitless.

Sofas, patio furniture, lamp shades, flooring tile, building materials. There's a place in Montclair where you can find a variety of items such as these for 50% or more off every day, plus the knowledge that each purchase is helping to make the community a better place in which to live. It's the PVHReStore, which Pomona Valley Habitat for Humanity operates to raise money for its





home-building activities for low-income families in the community. "But unless you've dropped into the store at 4609 Holt Blvd., Montclair, you probably don't realize there's so many bargains to be had", according to Imelda Rodriguez, assistant manager. And even if you have been there, there's a different look as the stock changes almost daily. "Every day we are receiving items from manufacturers, mostly over-stocked or returned items," she explained. Some of these items may have a small flaw or chip on them,

making them still useful at only a fraction of the usual price. Last month, for instance, the store received large amounts of donated items from retail companies, all quality products at greatly reduced prices. Imelda said one retailer provided overstocked lampshades,

while another donated a wide variety of patio furniture. Even an Internet home products firm



has donated many items, from sofas and vanities to appliances and pillows.
"Additionally", Imelda said, "the ReStore has recently reorganized several areas. It's designed to make it easier for the customer to find the merchandise they need."




