Mead's New World International Wine Competition for selecting them as its 26th Annual Wine Extravaganza beneficiary. This is the 7th year Pomona Valley Habitat has been the proud recipient of NWIWC's generosity.

On Sunday, April 17, 2016 the Jerry D. Mead's NWIWC Wine Extravaganza was held at the Ontario Airport Hotel and Conference Center. Special thanks to the co-producers, Laurie J. Crome and Jody E. Tillery-Gmeiner.



Thirty wineries participated and many prestigious awards were given. Don Galleano of The Historic Galleano Winery was on hand to receive his Jerry D. Mead's New World International Wine Competition, Grand Champion Award for his Non-Vintage Old Vine Port. This wine also won the Best Dessert Wine at the competition, Best of Varietal, Best of Class and a Gold Medal. Winemaker Galleano also received his Bronze Medal for his 2012 Old Vine Zinfandel.

Randy and Cindy from Craveyon Cloudwines attended the Wine Extravaganza and graciously poured for the wine loving crowd. They received two Double Gold medals. One was for their 2013 Counoise, Paso Robles, which not only received Double Gold but also a best of Varietal and a Best of Class award. They also picked up their Double Gold Medal for their 2013 Syrah, El Dorado County.

Max Gill, son of winemaker Michael Gill, of Michael Gill Cellars attended the event to pour their award winning wines. Max served and received medals for the 2013 Alicante Bouchet -Silver Medal winner, 2012 Syrah a Gold Medal winner and a Best of Class award, 2014 Tempranillo a Double Gold medal as well as a Best of Class and a Best Varietal award, and a Bronze Medal for the 2014 Viognier.

Also in attendance serving their award winning wines was a representative from Peachy Canyon Wines and Cirque du Vin. For Cirque du Vin, a Silver Medal was awarded to the 2012 Red Blend, and for Peachy Canyon, a Silver Medal was given for the 2013 Westside Zinfandel and a Gold Medal for the 2014 Incredible Red Zinfandel.




